Its sleek design marries steel with high-quality wood. Upon request, the Altus can be crafted from either structural or stainless steel, with a finish of either domestic or exotic wood. The Altus recycling bin boasts a three-compartment structure, each fitted with a galvanized liner. For waste separation, you can either use the liner alone, or implement colorcoded disposable bags. Altus is a highly functional model, with each wooden slat engraved with descriptions indicating the use of each compartment. The Altus recycling unit can be positioned as a standalone feature in places like shopping mall corridors or secured to the ground. Altus symbolizes both modernity and sophistication in city furnishings, all while promoting environmental responsibility.

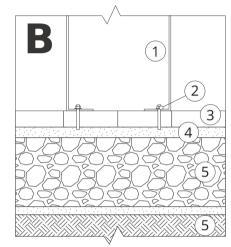

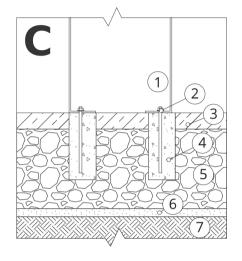

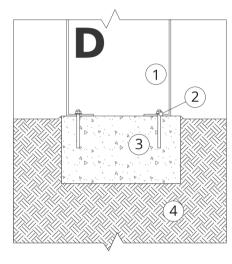
